## ROMANCE LANGUAGES AND LITERATURES

## Italian Supplementary Major - Literature and Culture Track

The Italian major on the Literature-Culture track requires 8 courses that total at least 24 credits beginning at 20201/20111 or above, consisting of:

- 1.) 6 courses taught in Italian: ROIT 20201 or ROIT 20111, ROIT 20202, ROIT 30310 (Passage to Italy), 2 seminar courses in advanced literature and culture (numbered 30711 and 30721 or the equivalent), and ROIT 53000 (Italian Senior Seminar);
- 2.) 2 electives: These courses may be Italian Studies courses taught in English

Equivalent literature and culture courses from international study programs or other universities may be substituted with departmental approval. A minimum of 50% percent of the credits toward the supplementary major must be taken in residence at Notre Dame.

## AP or SAT credit may not apply toward the major.

Students are allowed to take related course in English outside of the department of Romance Languages and Literatures (for example, in Art History, in Anthropology, Music, FTT, Classics, Architecture, Political Science, etc.) with the approval of the Associate Director of Undergraduate Studies in Italian. These courses will be counted as the two electives.
