The Minor in Portuguese and Brazilian Studies consists of 15 credits, 5 courses, 3 credits each. Pre-requisites: ROPO 10101 and 10102, or 10103 and 10104, or 10105 and 10106

### Requirements for the Minor

5 courses in Portuguese Language and Luso-Brazilian literature beyond the prerequisites (listed above); ROPO 20201 and 20202, and 3 additional courses at the 300/400 levels. Three of the five courses must be in Portuguese language and/or Luso-Brazilian literature, film and culture taught in Portuguese; the fourth and fifth courses may be on Luso-Brazilian literature, film and culture taught in English; the fourth and fifth courses may be on a Portuguese or Brazilian subject in another discipline (for example, Anthropology, History, Latin, American Studies, FTT, Political Science, Romance Languages and Literatures, Theology, etc.). Courses from foreign study programs or other universities may be substituted by permission, but at least three courses for the Portuguese minor must be taken in residence at Notre Dame. AP credit may not be applied toward the minor.
