The undergraduate major in Romance Languages and Literatures is designed for qualified students who wish to major in *two* programs (French, Italian, and Spanish). Cross-cultural in focus, the major recognizes the importance of studying the correspondence and difference among various Romance literature and cultures and of re-examining traditional disciplinary boundaries.

Requirements for the Romance Language Major include competency in *two* languages and successful completion of at least 36 credit hours or 12 courses at the 20202 - level and above, distributed equally between the two respective language programs as follows:
