

FRENCH AND FRANCOPHONE STUDIES MAJOR

The French and Francophone Studies major requires **10 courses that total at least 30 credits** beginning at 20202 or above, consisting of:

- 1.) ROFR 30310: Between the Lines: An Introduction to French Literary Analysis
- 2.) 1 course on French and Francophone literature and culture focusing on the period before 1800
- 3.) 1 course on French and Francophone literature and culture focusing on the period after 1800
- 4.) 4 electives at or above the 20202 level
- 5.) 3 electives at the 40000 level

ROFR 30310: Between the Lines is only offered on campus at Notre Dame and should be completed by the end of junior year. Students planning to study abroad should plan for this in advance. At least half of the major courses must be taken in residence at Notre Dame. Any substitutions or exceptions to the major requires the approval of the Director of Undergraduate Studies (DUS) or the Associate Director of Undergraduate Studies in French. AP credits may not be applied to the major.
